Item	Minutes
1.	Attendance, Minutes of Previous Meeting Gillian Sinclair was introduced as the new Project Director replacing Dan Murphy. Sarah Henderson was introduced as the new Estates Manager for the Calvert Site and Greatmoor Site replacing Alan Bulpin. Review of previous actions: 1. Ongoing, action carried over pending approval of the revised EMP. 2. Closed, discussed, BCC Transport now in process of sign removal. Date on last months minutes to be changed from July to October. No other comments and minutes accepted.
2.	Matters Arising Gillian Sinclair advised that the Bio-diversity Meeting was held on 4th December 2014. The Bechstein bats issue was raised in connection with the lighting. Gillian Sinclair confirmed FCC are aware that From April the bats come out of hibernation. She confirmed that by April that FCC will be in a different stage and lighting will be reduced. Kevin Shenton advised that BCC and AVDC were invited to the site to discuss current conditons during October 2014. BCC were pleased with the amendments made to the lights. Kevin Shenton also adivsed that some of the lighting will reduce and that the lights are directly above the site and does not encrouch outside the boundary. He also commented that FCC are moving into a different phase and more cladding is going up, this will reduce the light polution. Next month the tower crane is being dismantled and that will reduce the need for extra lighting in the next couple of months. FCC won't know the effect until the bats come out of hibernation. Following surveys of bats on behalf of HS2, it would appear that there are significaint number of bats present. A question was raised about the stack replacing the crane and that it will be very visible. Gillian Sinclair advised that the stack will require red lights on the stack as its a legal requirement. Gillian Sinclair to provide a comparison as to the red lights today and red lights on the stack. Gillian Sinclair stated that the lights have been angled down and the readings have reduced from 30 lux to 6 lux. FCC are doing everything they can to focus the lights on where required. The roundabout lighting at the entrance to the access road was discussed. Gillian Sinclair confirmed the lights were now switched off.

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	The brown signs were mentioned and Gillian Sinclair confirmed the 2 stand alone signs have been removed and the one on the Tingewick bypass will be removed at the end of the month. The black signs on the Buckingham bypass and Gawcott Village Centre (opposite the pub) were mentioned. April Rafety confirmed the 2 stand alone signs have been removed. Questions raised in advance of the meeting by David Evershed were discussed. The question raised about Improved Emission Filtration - BCC have no plans to make any changes, they are happy with the technology used and it meets all standards and regulatory requirements. It does what it needs to do. APCR disposal / treatment – FCC may no longer treat hazardous waste prior to disposal on site as per the planning application and set out as the policy of the County Council in its Minerals and Waste Core Strategy. BCC planning representative suggested that an amendment to the planning application could be required for a proposed alternative means of dealing with the hazardous fly ash and we would be notified in advance of the need for any such planning application. Supply of Residual Waste - Gillian Sinclair advised they are looking at different sources of waste, and will bring waste by rail as at Calvert at the moment. Currently FCC estimate that out of the 200,000tpa of capacity, not used by BCC, c.30-40% will be delivered by rail. HS2 Rail Disruption - Sarah Henderson discussed the alternative sites for relocating the sidings by HS2. HS2 have 4 options A-D and FCC are in favour of option D; relocating to the south of Sheephouse wood. Air and Soil Quality Monitoring – Gillian Sinclair advised no change is required. AVDC will consider its position but BCC stated it will not undertake an additional air or soil quality monitoring.
3.	Site Report <u>Greatmoor</u> Gillian Sinclair gave a brief presentation to the group showing the progress at site since the last Community Liaison Group meeting. <u>Access Road</u>

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4.	Any Other Business A number of questions were asked of FCC: FCC are handling and monitoring wastes from the site, including deemed hazardous (APC residues). Gillian Sinclair stated that the hazardous waste is being continually monitored as per the regulation in the environment permit. Gillian Sinclair advised that FCC will include the links to the Environment Agency when the minutes of the meeting are distributed. What is happening to the laying the cables to East Claydon? Gillian Sinclair advised that FCC programme is with RCD and WDP and looking to commence works end of March / April 2015. Gillian Sinclair advised that the cable work under the railway line has ben completed. The cable will come in sections. How long will the cabling work take? Gillian Sinclair advised it is estimated to take 6 weeks, and will get back to everyone with a more accurate time.
