1.	Attendance, Minutes of Previous Meeting The minutes of the last meeting were agreed.
2 & 3	Matters Arising / Site Report 100% availability 55,000t of waste combusted 140 MWh electricity generated Greatmoor is shutdown due to power down. Western Power do not pay us any compensation for this. So we are using this time to carry out some maintenance works prior to winter months. Main outage will not be displaced in May 2020. Sample inspections done, no conformity waste was removed. Assesseline bottles etc. Proximity Tabs gave us the warning and they are removed. We can send these back to the originator if we find out where they come from. If they are in the pit it isn't possible to do this. 31 Near Miss Employee injury – cut on upper arm. Operator caught on tag but was fine and this was reported and the tag was removed. 19 Near Miss Hazard. Hydraulic Leak etc, a piece of electric piece of equipment. Headlines This month introduced a new set of safety rules. We have piloted this new set of safety rules for the company. HS2 road access – no update at this stage. The southern mound has slippage on it and remedial engineering works started at the end of May and will continue to September – works due to be completed in the next couple of weeks. Membrane to go down then the rest of soil replaced and reseeded. Mobile Mask Request to put telephone mask on the building or on site for the area. Want improvement to signal to local area. This is down to BCC to agree or look into. FCC can't put mask on the end of the stack. It has its own regulation for safety reasons so no this will create its own problems. Possible to put on the site somewhere but this has to be brought up with BCC – Village Network was mentioned in this regard.

4.	Emissions Report PD went through slides on this. New layout shown. No issues. Reducing NOX we will be well below these. Changes in legislation will be very minimum effort to comply. Reporting of Weight – on public register. We report total emissions as a mass. As per Summary slide shown. 10 pages of substances and as shown in the permit. Carbon Dioxide how as a company do we offset this. Paula will look into this for next meeting. Summary No issues on site. Accredited ISO 150001 issued last month. 
5.	Visitor Centre Since last meeting 1 Million Tonnes tipped and celebrated on 6th September 19. We reached the milestone of 5000 visitors to Greatmoor. We asked for ideas how we can celebrate this, so thought we would sponsor a local charity called Therabee – Mid Bucks Bee Keeping Association approached and assisted us.
