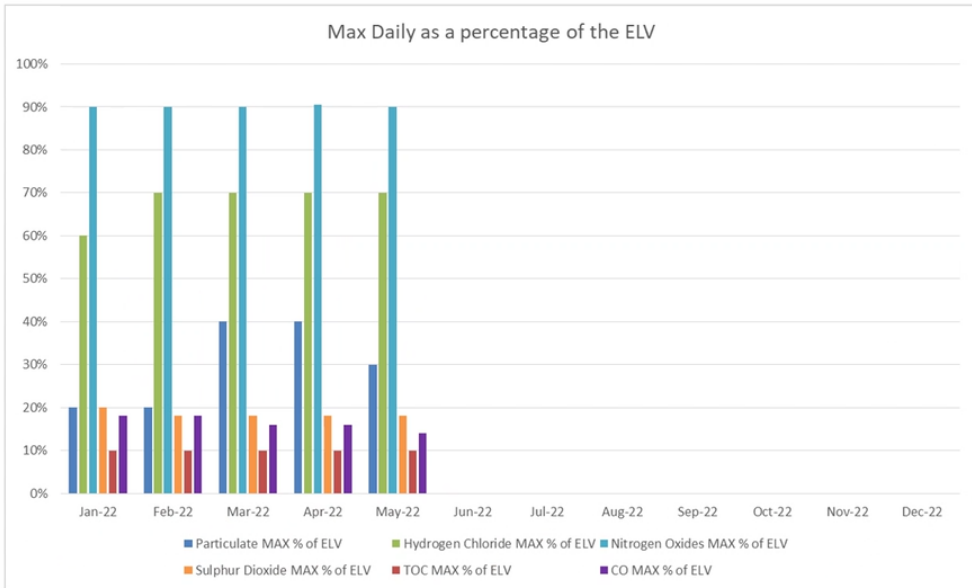

	Response: As above in pink/purple. 2 bridges Traffic bridge 49M wide Track for Farmer and Bridleway. Another bridge GUA1 footpath at the London mark on the SCL13 footpath to southern portal SHWBMS.
3	Operational Update – Calvert Landfill Slides shown. JL – shows Agenda from Calvert Landfill. 2000t/month to bring site up to the approved contours in that area and some capping – soils to landfill as opposed to industrial waste. Engineering works completing foundation work. See Appendix B. Office and workshop relocations starting from end of August. Solar Panels for next 35 years and then revert to the current scheme. Footpaths – no update The full diversion to footpath 14 and the bridal way that was the temporary diversion around site that's been closed since 2020 due to the works being carried out by HS2 and but I just wanted to confirm that you can access the back of site from the edge side and you can access that bridal path at the back of the landfill site. You can turn, you can turn right or you can turn left towards Dunsty Hill. Once you reach the Dunsty hill corner, then you can. You can continue on the footpath that goes through the wood at the back of the site. PG – asked about access to bridleway from Calvert to the path that is going to run along HS2. Footpath access from Brackley Lane may be approved by HS2. On western side a cycle path may be put in from North portal area on SM plan. This is HS2 arranging this.

	Incidents/Damage  • Greatmoor – 8 incidents with 'Damage or Loss to' tag: – 1 event where a delivery lorry tried to leave the tipping hall with its 'nets' up and caused damage to the roller shutter door. – 1 incident where a HGV pulled forward in the tipping hall, caught its trailer door on the wall and ripped it off – 2 incidents where high winds caused damage to the doors of the forklift. – 1 incident where a driver drove through the weighbridge barrier. – No incidents of flat tyres reported by staff linked to tramp metal on the road between the car park entrance and the IBA pad. Reducing number of punctures month on month. – 3 minor miscellaneous events
